Your comments on specific facts observed: Cultivation One beneficiary home garden had been provided with 5 fruit plants to the value of Rs.550/- (Rs.180/- valued one budded plant out of mango/orange/rambutan/durian/naran/pears/jack/mangustin, Rs.135/- valued 02 budded plants out of avocado/anoda/beli/goraka/guava/ jambola/jambo/lovi/sepadilla/kamaranka/wood apple/uguresa, Rs.50/- valued 02 budded plants out of gadiguda/passion fruit/guava/jack/jambo/lime/pemogranate/orange and vegetable seed packet of which matured plants as well as harvesting plants were observed □ Further space of the existing home gardens as well as additional land space too are available. Therefore it is better to supply additional plants to these beneficiaries for further encouraging them in the home gardening. It is appropriate to provide beneficiaries with subsidies as they are members of "Sithamu" Female womem's Organization to ensure the success of the home gardening programme. Only the organic fertilizer is applied in those home gardens. Therefore a suitable method has to be introduced to provide them with the particular type of fertilizer, if any in order to increases the harvest. Provision of protective nets watering buckets, water motors, hoses which being essential tools of home gardening. Provision of mare opportunities for training and conducting education and awareness programmes would help improve their knowledge in home gardening. Introduction of modern technology and high yielding new varieties.
